Why should the bed sensor be used?

Seniors often have a higher risk of falls and health problems. People with dementia can also be disoriented. Residents with limited mobility should receive support at an early stage. The overall aim is to increase general safety and well-being.

How does the bed sensor support everyday work?

The bed sensor can prevent falls or other dangerous situations. The automation of certain monitoring tasks allows care staff to focus on important aspects of care, which increases efficiency and reduces stress. In addition, residents and relatives feel safe knowing that help will be there quickly if needed.
