Why should the bed sensor be used?

The bed sensor is to be used for residents who are physically unable to walk independently but try to do so anyway and are therefore at risk of falling. It should also be used for residents with dementia who are no longer able to assess risks and dangers properly.

How does the bed sensor support everyday work?

The bed sensor enables care staff to provide prompt assistance after a person has gotten out of bed, thereby preventing falls. The bed sensor is easy and practical to use and is triggered immediately when an attempt is made to get out of bed.

Advantages

- > Immediate activation when getting out of bed
- > Easy to clean
- > Access to the bed possible without having to move the step mat on the floor, for example
- > Visually attractive - hardly visible or disruptive, supports residents' privacy

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
